Dress the Teddy

You can use clothes from a doll to do this activity. Make a washing line using some string and pegs. Ask your child to hang the clothes on the line. Start by asking them to find particular items, e.g. 'can you hang up the shorts?'

Once the clothes have been 'hung up' you can ask your child to name them.

Now use the clothes to dress a teddy.

You can give your child instructions to follow, for example;

'Put teddy's shoes on' or ask them to choose an item, name it then dress the teddy.



Make it easier:

- Before carrying out the activity, talk about the clothes you and your child are wearing.

Make it harder:

- Ask your child to tell you what clothes you would wear if the weather was hot/cold. How are these clothes the same and how are they different? e.g. 'Do we wear woollen clothes in the summer?' 'Why not?'
